

## **Funding Opportunity**

The Fred Hutchinson Cancer Research Center and the San Diego State University/University of California, San Diego Cancer Center Comprehensive Partnership are inviting applications to address disparities in colorectal cancer education, prevention, and treatment among underserved populations in the Geographical Management of Programs (GMAP) Region 6 (AK, WA, OR, CA, HI, American Samoa, Guam). The purpose of the GMAP initiative is to identify successful strategies that will help bring important scientific advances to diverse communities.

The RFA is open to non-profit organizations/groups in Hawaii as well as Guam, American Samoa and several western mainland states. Funding is limited to \$5,000 in direct funds plus 10% F&A costs for a one year period.

Note the December 23, 2011 application deadline and also note that one award is designated for Hawaii, and the awarded grantee will get to be part of a region-wide program addressing disparities in colorectal cancer.
