

## Ethics for Prevention Certification

**Purpose:** Ethics in Prevention will explore ethical issues in prevention practice using the Code of Ethical Conduct. Discussion will focus on its practical application in prevention practice. Participants will practice using an Ethical Decision Making Model in prevention work. We will look at how to assess the ethical qualities of organizational culture, as well as develop a Code of Professional Practice for prevention programs.

**Instructor:** As a Certified Prevention Specialist, Ken Smith facilitated Substance Abuse Prevention Specialist Trainings (SAPST) in Hawaii and the Pacific Island Entities. While a coordinator at CSAP's Western CAPT, he developed an online Ethics in Prevention course as well as an undergraduate course in Substance Abuse Prevention. Ken received a Master's degree in Public Health at the University of Hawaii, and has worked in the Prevention field for the past 15 years.
